Update – 7 October 2017

We are looking forward to seeing you at this unique event.

You will be welcome at Sickleholme Golf Club from 4:00 pm on 21st October, for rest of the afternoon and evening. Tea, coffee and biscuits will be available, at no extra charge, from then until about 6:00 pm. This will be a great opportunity to gather for a chat, look at the exhibits, watch the slide show, admire the celebration cake etc., before the dinner.

If arriving by car, please use the back car park. Go past the clubroom into the car park and turn up to the right.

The bar will be open from 4:00 pm until midnight. Please avoid the room with the snooker table, to the right of the bar, while Golf Club members are there (probably until about 6:00 pm).

Please arrive by 6.30 pm at the latest for the photograph. Because we have so many attending (115 at the time of writing) we can't get everybody into one photograph so there will be two groups. A list of those attending is on the Club website.

The dinner will start around 7.30pm. We will now be providing some wine on the tables at no extra charge. BYO not allowed!

If you can't remember what you ordered for a starter, don't worry, there will be a code on your name badge: SP for (leek and potato) Soup; SM for Salmon Mousse.

Last orders from the bar will be 11.30 pm and then we will be packing up in order to leave by midnight.

If you wish to leave your car overnight, that is OK.

If you want to camp or stay in a camper van, Swallowhome Camping and Caravan Park is just across the road (3 minutes' walk).

Don't forget the informal gathering at the Castle Inn, Twentywell Lane, Sheffield, from 8:00 pm. on Friday, the opening of the Clubroom on Saturday 11:00 am – 1:00 pm. and the activities based at the Grouse Inn, Froggatt on Sunday from 10:30 am. The cycling will be for mountain bikes.
